Liszt, in his brilliant work "The Gypsies and their Music in Hungary," says of the melodies which he has embodied in his ten sets of "Hungarian Melodies" and his fifteen "Hungarian Rhapsodies":—"I have, therefore, come to the conviction that these detached pieces, these different and scattered melodies, were dispersed, broken fragments of a grand totality, and should be considered a sort of national epic. By the expression "Rhapsody" it was my intention to designate the fantastically epic element which I believed to recognize in them.

The present Second Rhapsody is one of the best known and most popular works of this class.
